COVID-19 Best Practices

Welcome to the SMKC/TKC Agility trials at Crown Sports Center in Fruitland, Maryland. While we are excited to be able to hold our trial, for everyone's safety, we are incorporating the following best practices for the duration of the trial. **Please note that these are subject to change based on local, state, federal, site and AKC guidance.** We will do our best to keep you informed of any changes.

In signing your entry form, you agree to abide by the following guidelines:

1. If you are sick or a member of your household is sick, please stay home. We will shred your check if you or a family member becomes sick.
2. Bring your own face mask. **A face mask that covers both nose and mouth MUST always be worn in the building, even while you are running your dog. There will be no exceptions.**
3. When outside the building, you may remove your mask, but please practice appropriate social distancing.
4. If you would like to wear gloves, please bring your own.
5. The clubs will provide hand sanitizer – please use it frequently and/or bring your own.
6. We will have disinfectant soaked cloths at ring gates. Please use them as you enter and exit the rings.
7. There will be no spectator chairs in the ring area. Please practice appropriate social distancing when using the bleachers or other areas outside the ring.
8. Based on the AKC's Best Practices, we cannot allow MACH/PACH cakes.
9. The café may not be open and there will not be a food truck on site. We will not be providing snacks for workers, so please bring your own snacks and/or lunch.
10. Crating will be allowed inside the building, but please leave 6 feet of social distancing space between setups of "unrelated" dogs. If you are crating inside, please keep your setup as small as possible to ensure that there is adequate space for everyone. As always, you are welcome to crate out of your vehicle.
11. Crown will screen everyone daily upon first entry into the building with a temperature check and a brief questionnaire about COVID exposure. Once you have been screened for the day, you will receive a wristband, which must be worn to ensure access to the building for that day. (If you lose your wristband, please be prepared to be re-screened by Crown staff.)
12. Crown will clean the building periodically during the day and sanitize the ring and crating area each night. Crown Care (day care) will be in another part of the building. To the best of our knowledge, all other sports activities will be held outside and the arcade may be closed for the weekend. The clubs will sanitize equipment each night.
13. In the event that the trial must be cancelled due to State Regulations, we will shred all entry fee checks.

By signing your entry form, you acknowledge receipt and understanding of these guidelines and agree to adhere to them while at the trial site. Anyone who chooses not to abide by these practices may be subject to a bench committee hearing.
